Golden Township will be working the next few months writing new 5-year Park and Recreation Plan to submit to the Michigan Department of Natural Resources for their approval. An approved plan is required before MDNR Trust Fund grant applications can be submitted. The process will begin with a survey of resident opinions of current parks and what improvements would enhance them. This survey will be available online at [goldentownship.org](http://goldentownship.org) and at the township offices during regular business hours. Responses should be returned by May 31, 2018. A public Forum will be held Saturday June 9, 2018 at the township offices to gather public input on park and recreation opportunities in the township. After this information is compiled a new plan will be completed and made available to the public for 30-day review period. A public hearing will be held to take comments. Public notices will be on the website and in the Oceana Herald Journal.
