

GOLDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD MINUTES
NOVEMBER 8TH, 2006
GOLDEN TOWNSHIP HALL

The regular monthly meeting of the Golden Township board was called to order by Chairman Walsworth at 7:30 P.M. Members present Walsworth, Cargill, Ackley & Kolosci. Fuehring absent. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

The minutes of the October 10th, 2006 meeting were read.

Motion by Cargill Support by Ackley to approve the October 10th minutes, all yes motion carried.

Correspondence was read:

DEQ Letter concerning Mike Fuller violations and a denial letter from Frank Adams regarding the dumping on the Fuller property.

Election update Golden had 897 voters for the November 7th, 2006 General Election.

The Treasurers report was reviewed.

Motion by Ackley Support by Walsworth to approve the Treasurers report all yes motion carried.

Presentation of the bills:

Motion by Kolosci Support by Ackley to approve check numbers 11864-11908 totaling \$23,728.74. Roll call vote Ackley, Cargill, Walsworth & Kolosci all yes, motion carried.

The Shearer Land division was discussed, per the zoning report received from the Zoning administrator, who was absent from the meeting the land division meets all requirements and is recommended for approval.

Motion by Ackley Support by Cargill to approve the Shearer Land Division for parcel # 64-006-004-300-01 all yes motion carried.

A flat fee for private road signs ordered through the Township was discussed, Kolosci will research and report at the next meeting.

The Cemetery was discussed: Kolosci stated that Mr. Vega had been to the cemetery and given a price of \$50.00 per stump to be ground out and \$75. to \$100.00 to remove the stump underground with a backhoe.

Motion by Cargill Support by Ackley to hire Vega custom tree removal to grind stumps and remove dead limbs from trees at the cemetery and around the Township Hall. Roll Call Vote All yes motion carried.

A letter from Breakaway Bay LLC was received asking that the Township pass a resolution to show support for the roads in the Timber Terrace located in Section 4 of Golden Township to be turned over to the Oceana County road commission.

WHEREAS, Breakaway Bay, LLC has requested of the Golden Township board a Resolution supporting its application to the Oceana County Road Commission for acceptance as public roads by the Oceana County Road Commission of the roads known as “Novadoc Boulevard” “Davoc Drive” “Pine Ave” and Minch Ave. presently located in the Timber Terrace Condominium in Section 4 of Golden Township; and the Township Board feels that it is in the best interest of the property owners abutting said roads and the Township in general for the said roads to be accepted as public and taken over by the Oceana County Road Commission.

NOW THEREFORE, it is resolved that the Golden Township Board supports Breakaway Bay, LLC in its application to the Oceana County Road Commission to accept as public and take over jurisdiction of “Novadoc Boulevard”, “Davoc Drive”, “Pine Ave” and Minch Ave. presently located in and North of the Timber Terrace Condominium in Section 4 of Golden Township.

Roll call vote: Walsworth yes, Cargill yes, Ackley yes, Kolosci yes, Fuehring absent.

Chairman Walsworth ask for Public input:

It was said that at Bunny Lane and Duck rd. they are burning leaves on the road and that it is doing damage to the surface.

The board was reminded that the 911 numbers are suppose to be put on the road signs as we place new signs. Kolosci will rewrite the form adding space for the information to be turned into the Road Commission.

Motion by Cargill Support by Ackley to go into Closed Session at 8:00pm, all yes motion carried.
