

GOLDEN TOWNSHIP BOARD MINUTES
SEPTEMBER 12TH, 2006
GOLDEN TOWNSHIP HALL

The regular monthly meeting of the Golden Township Board was called to order by Chairman Walsworth at 7:30 P.M.. Members present Walsworth, Cargill, Ackley, Fuehring and Kolosci. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

Motion by Cargill Support by Fuehring to accept the minutes as read, all yes motion carried.

Correspondence from Terry Robinson of 4335 N. Ridge Rd. Mears was read, regarding a golf cart or ATV on the beach on 9/2/06. The complaint stated that the vehicle came down the road at Timber Lake Campground. Mr. Nameth stated that another resident attempted to stop the vehicle but was unsuccessful, but told Mr. Nameth that it was a black ATV and that he had tracked it back to the Timber Lake Campground. No one called the police, but did contact the campground security office. Kolosci will send a letter to Timber Lake campground asking for a response to the situation.

Motion by Ackley Support by Fuehring to approve the Treasurers report, all yes motion carried.

Presentation of the bills:

Motion by Fuehring Support by Ackley to approve check numbers 11800-11825 totaling \$12,905.43, roll call vote: Ackley, Cargill, Walsworth, Fuehring & Kolosci all yes motion carried.

The Brubaker Land Division was discussed it meets all requirements and Zoning administrator Whelpley recommends approval.

Motion by Cargill Support by Fuehring to approve the Brubaker Land division parcel number 64-006-023-200-02 (06-03) all yes motion carried.

Kolosci gave the clean up day report approximately 101 patrons, 4/30yd. trash containers (18.7 tons total) 1/20yd. compost & wood container, 22 Freon appliances, 68 passenger tires & 1/30yd. metals container.

Money taken in the day of the event totaled \$362.00, the amount of money that the metals will bring is unknown at this time, RE-TEC will mail the check. The total bill for the event was \$3405.00, this total does not include the money taken in for the metals or the day of the event. Over all it was a great turn out with many compliments.

Public input was asked for, It was asked why aren't the propane tanks owned by Shell are not fenced in? A neighbor of the tanks stated that it seemed to be very unsafe with all the valves etc. exposed. Chairman Walsworth will contact the company to see what their plans are for the tanks.

Ridge Road residences asked when Ridge Road would be striped, it was said that the Road Commission planned to paint this fall.

Motion by Kolosci Support by Cargill to adjourn, time 8:00 P.M. motion carried.
