- Seasonal Closure of Cemetery from December 1 to April 1.
- Cemetery plots or burial spaces shall be sold only to residents or taxpayers of the township.
- No burial spaces shall be opened and closed except under the direction and control of the cemetery sexton.
- All burials shall be within a standard concrete vault installed or constructed in each burial space before interment.
- All markers or memorials must be of stone or other equally durable composition.
- One monument, marker or memorial shall be permitted per burial space.
- Military markers may be used by themselves or placed on the back of a monument.
- Footings or foundations shall be constructed by the township sexton.
- Headstones may only be placed at the west end of the burial plot.
- One full burial is allowed in a burial space except for a mother and infant or two children buried at the same time.
- Two cremation burials are allowed in one grave space.
- Urns, containers, and flowers should be placed in the row of the monuments.
- No shrubs, trees, or vegetation of any type shall be planted without approval of the township.
- The township reserves the right to remove or trim any tree, plant, or shrub located within the cemetery.
- The township shall have the right to remove and dispose of any and all growth, emblems, displays or container therefore that through decay, deterioration, damage, or otherwise become unsightly, or source of litter or a maintenance problem. The township shall not be held liable for stolen or damaged items left grave side.
- After October 1, containers and flowers left in the cemetery may be disposed of by the Township.
- Beginning 2017, the length of a monument on a **single plot** may be limited to 36" in length. (48" bases and monuments encroach on neighboring plots)  
If any part of the ordinance is found to be illegal, it does not void the other provisions.
