**Correspondence:** Helen Pische called to report theft of a hanging basket in Mears Cemetery.

**The Treasurer read the Financial Report.** The ending balance in the Fund as of September 10, 2019 was as follows: General Fund \$43,054.09; Road fund \$764.58; Capitol Savings Fund \$2,478.36. The Michigan Class investment funds for the above funds are as follows: GF \$83,098; RF \$0; CSF 72,236.

**Budget Amendment:** Motion by Mrs. Iteen, supported by Mrs. Cargill to approve budget amendment totaling \$168,834 to increase 101-101-801.000 professional services for \$61,000, 101-101-811.000 membership & subscriptions \$189, and 201-000-775.000, road operating maintenance and repairs for \$107,645. Roll call vote all yes, the motion carried.

**Bills:** Motion by Mr. Walsworth, supported by Mrs. Cargill to pay check numbers 18006 through 18044, and EFT 115 in the general fund for the amount of \$61,138.91. Roll call vote all yes, the motion carried.

**Zoning:** There have been 63 permits so far this year which includes 12 new homes. A Court Case was won concerning a RV on vacant land. The resident paid the fee and moved the RV. Historical Society wants to expand and is looking into acquiring additional land.

## **Reports:**

**Park Signs:** Motion by Mrs. Cargill, supported by Mr. Walsworth to approve payment of a few new signs for the Golden Township Park at Silver Lake Sand Dunes. The signs will be to keep adults off the children's swings and to have the pavilion plastic wind blocks rolled back up after use. Roll call all yes, the motion carried.

**Johnson Square Well and Building:** Motion by Mr. Walsworth, supported by Mrs. Cargill to approve a well and small building for the tank and also supplies for Johnson Square. Roll call vote all yes, the motion carried.

**Planning Commission:** Approval was given for a storage barn on Cihak property.

**Road:** Road projects have been completed for this year. The new rule is that every the third summer after paving a road, a fog coat seal coat and fog coat will need to be done.
